



RELEASABLE SPEAR

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Wellvene Releasable Spear has been designed with a range of interchangeable slip sizes to suit internal GS fishing neck profiles from 1 ¼" – 7" and an adjustment sleeve to allow for varying reach configurations when engaging internally into assemblies with damaged or no fishing neck.

Supplied in a range of sizes to suit operational requirements, the tool can be used within 2 3/8" tubing up to 9 5/8" casing.

Although the Releasable Spear only requires downward jarring to shear the release pin, a Double Jar Down Adaptor (DJDA) can be supplied where there may be a requirement to eliminate the potential for premature shearing of the tool during prolonged or severe downward jarring when latching into a fish neck or tool body.

Subsequent upward jarring can also be applied indefinitely or until the tool being

retrieved is released. This upward action merely shears the shear pin in the DJDA mechanism to allow the tool to transfer into the pre-release position. Further downward jarring will shear the release pin, allowing retrieval of the Spear from the fishing neck.

Job specific Cores can be supplied to suit operational requirements with threads cut into the bottom of the Core to accommodate equalizing prongs and pulling probes.
